



Email News Update – August 2010

Despite the promise of early snowfalls the season got off to a slow start, and it was thanks to the expanded snowmaking facilities at Perisher that made skiing reasonable, although somewhat limited in area during June and July. This has now improved with steady snowfalls since early August, and now some major dumps that are now being reported as amongst the best snow conditions for a decade. Current comments from the lodge are of 20 cm overnight falls of terrific dry powder. All 47 lifts are open and operating, the conditions are great, and there are plenty of places available from September onwards!

We have been well booked this ski season, but there are still some bookings available from early September (except for the week commencing 18th), and with the discounted Shoulder rates commencing from 11th September. - The Pub-to-Pub Classic will be held on 2nd September, the 28th annual Pub-to-Pub will be a cross-country mix of serious racers and others, enjoying themselves.
- The Australian Children's Skiing Championships will be held from 4th to 7th September, the nation's best junior skiers contest for national honours and points on a path for a world ranking.
- The Coca-Cola Spring Carnival will be held from 6th to 19th September, enjoy taking in indoor and outdoor entertainment including live music, fun kids activities, events, cultural activities, fireworks and much more.
- The Australian Interschools will be held from 8th to 12th September, school children from Year 1 to Year 12, having progressed through Divisional and State championships, move on to Perisher to find the country's best skiers and snowboarders across every competitive discipline.
- The Perisher Cup will be held from 18 to 19 September, being brought forward this year from the October long weekend. The organisers are seeking team entries from Perisher based clubs. Special Deals

Save up to 25%+ on the regular lift ticket rates with the Super Spring Value Season tickets which are valid from 6 September, prices for 5 day Adult/Child Passes are \$338/\$194 (extra for Skitube). These tickets must be pre-purchased before 31 August by calling 1300 655 811, so get in quickly.

Otherwise rates are discounted by 15% from 6 September with Spring Season tickets with 5 day Adult/Child Passes available from \$393/\$225 (extra for Skitube).

Brief details of mountain activities in Perisher Valley are:

- Perisher night skiing on Tuesday and Saturday nights from 6-9pm is currently scheduled through to the end of the season (nb: dates subject to change).
- Perisher fireworks on Thursday nights at 7pm is scheduled through to the end of season, subject to weather (nb: dates subject to change).
- Guided mountain host tours are scheduled every Thursday at 10am, meet under the trail guide sign near the Perisher Quad Express, intermediate and above skiers only.
- Join in on snow shoe tours at night during the full moon (4 Sept) and learn about mountain fauna and flora, for bookings call Perisher Guest Services on 1300 655 822.

A few reminders:

- Lids for Kids is a current initiative on the slopes, helmets are now compulsory for Kid's programs and lessons.
